REPRESENTATIVE SUCCESSES

- **Kummel v. Old World** – Secured a defense verdict in a business tort-contract dispute involving approximately \$15 million in assets after a one-month trial.
- **Millard v. Kent Realty** – Successfully secured a unanimous plaintiff jury verdict in favor of real estate investors against a real estate company selling investment properties. The award successfully included \$300,000 in punitive damages after approximately a one-month jury trial.
- **Security Pacific Mortgage Co. v. Nourian** – Successfully secured a plaintiff jury verdict (12-0), including fraud and punitive damages in excess of \$1 million.
